## Fight Against Organised Crime Challenges:

- Improved surveillance capabilities for land and sea areas
- Detection and analysis of concealed drugs
- Follow the drug smuggling money HAWALA and cryptocurrencies
- Intercept and decrypt communications
- Acquire, exchange, and utilise intelligence across different agencies, organisations, and countries





## Natural Hazards & Technological Accidents Challenges

- Reliable and Real-Time Information on Crisis Communication
- Not all stakeholders share the same operational picture
- Inadequate perception of risk and lack of risk awareness
- Lack of a standardized and interdisciplinary methodology for developing prevention plans
- Low Earth Observation





#### Methodology

- 1. MEDEA started with operational scenarios (for current and emerging threats) developed by practitioners.
  - a. Practitioners first analysed the scenarios and identified operational shortcomings.
  - b. These shortcomings were evolved to Capability Gap Findings (CGFs).
- 2. The CGFs led to an Open Call for Ideas and Solutions.
- 3. Open Call submissions and Professional networking enable the RDI days.


