## Proposal idea/content

<u>Establish</u> a sustainable network of <u>Disaster Resilience</u> stakeholders – comprising practitioners, industry, research organizations, policy makers - that will support cooperative activity and offer cocreation RDI opportunities to <u>tackle</u> existing and emerging threats according a properly established roadmap on the uptake and industrialisation of relevant RDI results.

## **Main objectives:**

- **Gather and organize existing knowledge** (technologies, methods, tools, etc.) from previous and ongoing DRS/GM projects to work on the capability gaps identified by IFAFRI and the EU networks of practitioners in cooperation with DRMKC Disaster Risk Management Knowledge Centre
- KERRNEL Platform: Online Knowledge Hub & Collaboration Platform
  - Limited-access repository with the identified capability gaps and outcomes derived from security research, available for practitioners and stakeholders
  - Open-access repository with the identified and categorised standards and certification schemes required for the different kind of solutions
  - Online dashboard gathering and presenting all news, opportunities and constraints relevant to the industrialisation of results, available for practitioners and stakeholders
  - Promote collaboration among relevant stakeholders through Direct Messaging and Blogging capabilities, share of relevant events and collaborative activities, WG establishment, etc.
- Promote the uptake or the industrialization of prominent results through short term joint events in well-established test sites (e.g., living labs, exercises and demos) under standardised validation procedures. Regarding the formulation of concrete uptake recommendations, KERRNEL will work to alleviate relevant operational, technical, legal, and financial constraints from.
- Define priorities for future research and establish a continuous dialogue with the EC services to promote R&D results and knowledge to the operational DRS community
